Homework! Forms! Permission Slips! This week we have learnt another sound p and are beginning to blend sounds together to make words.


We continued our Bear In A Boat adventure and this week we focused on creating fairground attractions. We loved having P₃/₄ as critical friends who helped us improve our structures.


